**DEATH OF FORMER LORD MAYOR, IRENE ELLISON-WOOD**

It is with regret that I must report the death, on 17 March 2022, of former Lord Mayor, Irene Ellison-Wood.

Irene served the constituents of the Keighley West Ward from 1990 to 2007, and did so with great vigour and no small amount of personal charm. She was invariably approachable, practical and pragmatic in serving those in her Ward. Irene was determined, even dogged, when dealing with difficult or persistent problems and this earned her much admiration among those whom she so ably represented over her 17 years as a Councillor.

Irene served in Civic Office first as Deputy Lord Mayor in 2001/2002 and then as Lord Mayor in 2004/2005. She took to the roles with much enthusiasm and her year as First Citizen was marked by her customary warmth and an easy good humour, which helped all those she met to overcome any sense of natural reticence when meeting the Lord Mayor.

Members and Officers will doubtless wish to join me in expressing our sadness at her loss and to place on record our gratitude for her time and hard work on this Council.

The service was led by Acting Dean, Revd Canon Paul Maybury of Bradford Cathedral, together with Pastor Oliver Evans, the Club Chaplain and a blessing was given by the Bishop of Bradford, The Rt Revd Dr Toby Howarth.
